The per service rate for section Service Players is \$131.22 during the 2016-17 38-week winter and 5-week summer seasons. Salary is not individually negotiable and may be prorated based on start date. Benefits presently include pension and access to instrument insurance. Employment terms and conditions are detailed by the CBA.
